

Each year, the Florida Department of Education (FDOE) surveys parents of children with an individual educational plan (IEP) to determine how well your child's school is partnering with you and promoting your involvement in your child's education. Individual responses are confidential, and no personal identifiable information will be included in data or reports provided to the FDOE or districts. Skyward Family Access allows parents and guardians of Citrus County students to be part of the educational process by using state-of-the-art encryption technology to provide a secure Internet link, allowing parents and guardians the opportunity to monitor educational progress, view students information, and communicate with teachers.

How Safe is Your Child's Car Seat?

Recent car seat check-ups in Citrus County showed that out of 98 car seats inspected, only 9 were used correctly and installed securely. So where do parents and caregivers go for help to be sure they have it right? The answer is to have the car seat checked by a certified child passenger safety technician. A twenty minute car seat inspection is free, the hands-on education is important to make sure the seat is installed correctly, and most importantly, it can save the life of a child. Even if you think your car seat is correct.....take 20 minutes to be sure.

If your child needs a car seat, new safety seats are available for \$30 for income eligible families.
