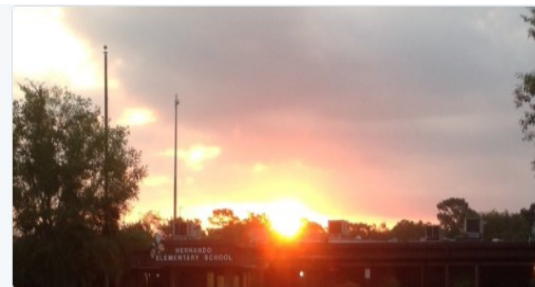

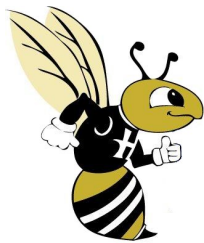


FSA Testing

Ms. Spell's class will welcome parents on May 19th at 11:00.

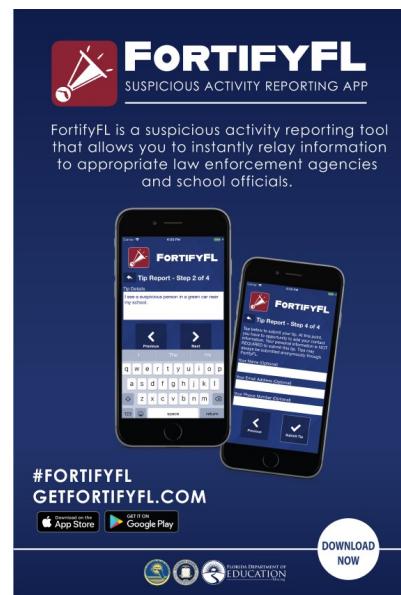
Ms. Shaffer's class will welcome parents on May 20th at 11:00.
